# SERMON NOTES

## **Morning Sermon: Christ Loves His Sheep—John 10:7-21**

- I. Real Security (7–9)
  - A. Above all, the sheep need security and safety.
  - B. Christ is the Door, making the sheep safe and secure. He is the only Door.
  - C. Only those who enter through Christ may enter.
- II. Unique Freedom (9–10)
  - A. That you may have pasture.
  - B. That you may have abundant life.
- III. Genuine Certainty (11–15)
  - A. I am the Good Shepherd who will lay down My life for My sheep.
  - B. I am the true Shepherd, not an imposter.
  - C. I am the atoning Shepherd who knows His own and is known by His own.
- IV. New Identity (16–21)
  - A. One flock and one Shepherd.
  - B. Loved by the Father and charged by the Father.
  - C. He is accused of having a demon but does not have a demon.
