SERMON NOTES

Morning Sermon: Many Believed—John 10:31-42

- I. Their Reason for Wanting to Stone Jesus—Blasphemy (31–33)
 - A. "The Jews" refers not to all Jews but to a group of Jews orchestrating opposition behind the scenes.
 - B. The Jews were spurred to action, picking up stones in response to "I and the Father are one."
 - C. The defense: In response to their verbal attacks, Jesus calls attention to His works, which prove who He is.
 - D. A revision: Their understanding of God needed correction.
- II. If My Works Are Not God's Works, Then by All Means—Don't Believe (34–39)
 - A. It is written: Evidence shows that the Scriptures were given as God's Word.
 - B. Since it is written by God's decree, you should refrain from protesting when I call Myself the Son of God.
- III. Everything That John Said About Jesus Was True—And Many Believed in Him Then (40–42)
 - A. Jesus went away, leaving the cities to prepare for the next battle while preaching, and many came to faith.
 - B. Without the aid of signs and wonders, John the Baptist ministered.
 - C. Many believed in Him there.
